
Adding CEL Attribute to Course

Community-engaged learning is a community-led action, research, or learning experience that utilizes critically reflective practice to enhance social responsibility and collaboration while developing and leveraging professional skills toward community-desired outcomes and impact. This designation can be added to one or more sections of a course by adding the CEL (Community-Engaged Learning) attribute in the Course Curriculum setup. Please note: this course attribute designation is separate from the CEP (Community Engagement Pathway) course designation. The CEP designation is assigned to courses that have been approved for the general education Community Engagement Pathway through CAPC. All Community Engagement Pathway classes should also be assigned the CEL attribute but many CEL sections will not have the Community Engagement Pathway designation.

Course Attributes are added in CLSS.

- 1. Find the desired course in CLSS.
- 2. In the attributes section, click on the pencil edit button.



3. In the Attributes section click the green + sign, then select the "community engaged learning" attribute.
