Policies and Recommendations

- A minimum grade of "C" must be earned in all courses.
- For electives, students can also choose selected culture cluster courses offered by the department of foreign languages with the advanced approval of the International Business Coordinator.
- Students are encouraged to concentrate on a specific region of the world by selecting courses particular to a country and/or region. For example, students who choose to study the Russian language should take courses related to the politics, history, economy, or culture of Russia.
