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Overview & Key Findings

The following provides contextual information regarding the administration of the Employer Survey for Initial and Advanced-Level educator preparation programs at West Chester University of Pennsylvania.

Purpose: The Employer Survey is administered to employers of alumni to measure

their satisfaction with the preparation of program completers. Additionally, these data are used to improve our programs to ensure program completers

are prepared to meet the requirements and expectations of today's

employers.

Survey Respondents: Principals and Assistant Principals from all public schools in Chester and

Delaware Counties and select public schools in Philadelphia County.

Survey Type: Proprietary (Skyfactor Benchworks)

Administration Type: Online

Administration Dates: March 19, 2024 – April 12, 2024

Response Rate: 7.6% (30 out of 395 total survey participants)

Minimum Acceptable

Level of Expectations: For questions 1-19, the minimum is a rating of 5.

For question 20, the minimum is a rating of "About as prepared as others."

Key Findings

❖ 77% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with recent graduates regarding their commitment to their job. (Source: Question 6)

- * 83% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with recent graduates regarding their ability to build collaborative professional relationships. (Source: Question 10)
- * 78% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with recent graduates regarding their ability to integrate technology into the teaching experience. (Source: Question 16)
- ❖ 77% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with recent graduates regarding their overall performance. (Source: Question 18)
- ❖ 80% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) likely to recommend their schools hire graduates from our educator preparation programs. (Source: Question 19)
