Survey Results by PASSHE Campus

ABSTRACT

This report gives a summary of the 2020 Ram Poll for each of the 13 participating PASSHE institutions. The poll was taken in October of 2020, prior to the November election. The estimators provided are unweighted. Sample sizes for each campus are provided.

The 2020 Ram Poll

Our intention was to capture the opinions of Pennsylvania college students. The 14 universities of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education (PASSHE) enroll "the largest number of Pennsylvania residents among all four-year colleges and universities in the Commonwealth." Over 80,000 students currently were attending PASSHE schools in fall of 2020. Students who attend and graduate from PASSHE schools are likely to be lifetime Pennsylvania residents, so capturing their political opinions may give an indication of which direction the state is moving. This year, 13 of the 14 universities agreed to participate in the 2020 Ram Poll. Our target population was undergraduate students who are permanent Pennsylvania residents above the age of 18.

The survey findings in this report are based on a web-based survey conducted between October 12, 2020 and October 18, 2020. We obtained random samples of email addresses from each participating university via the PASSHE Advanced Data Analytics Office. All email addresses were taken from our target population; the sample excluded out-of-state and international students as well as students not of voting age.

Over 13,000 students received an email on Monday, October 12 with a link to the Qualtrics survey. The initial email and all reminder emails are contained in a separate document and are available upon request. Each email explained that the survey was about the upcoming Presidential election, that it would take no longer than 3 minutes to complete, and that upon completion they would be entered into a raffle for a chance to win a \$25 Amazon gift card. The survey closed at 12:00 pm on Sunday, October 18. The resulting sample size was n = 1676 students. Our response rate was 12.6%. Our sample of 1676 students represent 2.3% of the target population.

At the start of the survey, students were asked if they were registered to vote. If they answered no, they were not permitted to answer the questions about voting (candidate, party and voting mode). This explains the differential in sample sizes for different questions.

Campus Reports

In this report, we provide the results of the survey by PASSHE campus. Crosstabulations are not provided due to the small sample sizes but are available upon request. The full 2020 Ram Poll report, which includes crosstabulations and regional analysis, can be found here. Please note that the sample sizes for many of the campuses are small. For example, there are five schools (ESU, Edinboro, Clarion, LHU, and Mansfield) with fewer than 100 respondents.

Margins of error for the estimators in this report were not calculated but will be very large. Additionally, the estimators in this report are not weighted.

Region Definitions

Party affiliation, or more recently a voter's stance on President Trump, is defined geographically in Pennsylvania. The center of the state is solidly red, while the urban corners are blue and their suburbs are growing bluer. In their <u>Washington Post 9/8/20 article</u>, Dave Weigel and Lauren Tierney carved Pennsylvania into seven political "states" by organizing adjacent counties. For the 2020 Ram Poll, students were asked to include home county in the survey and were assigned a region based on the definitions of Weigel and Tierney. Regions are defined in Table 1.
